## ON-SITE GRADUATE PROGRAMS

### **BUSINESS ANALYTICS (CERTIFICATE)**

- ▶ Develop your skills in data mining, exploration, preparation, regression analysis, and more.
- ▶ Complete four courses in just two semesters (Some online courses required).
- ▶ Based in the Computer Science and Mathematics Department for hands-on learning.
- ▶ Some online courses required

### **CLINICAL MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING (MA)**

- ▶ Offered on the main campus in Poughkeepsie in an accelerated, two-year, or a less time intense three-year full-time format.
- ▶ Rich in courses in counseling and assessment as well as human development, diversity, and research.
- ▶ Opportunity to specialize in clinical areas such as grief counseling, counseling children and adolescents, and counseling the seriously mentally ill.
- ▶ Graduates of the program fulfill the New York State Department of Education's academic, practicum, and internship requirements for the Mental Health licensure exam.
- ▶ No GRE required

### **COMPUTER SCIENCE/SOFTWARE DEVELOPMENT (MS)**

- ▶ Offered on the main campus in Poughkeepsie.
- ▶ Graduates of the program receive a comprehensive theoretical foundation in computer science, together with the state-of-the-art skills required of those interested in the design, development, and implementation of software systems.
- ▶ Two tracks: Cloud Computing or Mobile Computing.
- ▶ Virtual Computing Laboratory makes working on projects off-campus convenient.
- ▶ No GRE required

### **EDUCATION (MS) IN CONTEMPORARY CURRICULUM & INSTRUCTION**

- ▶ Offered on the main campus in Poughkeepsie or in a hybrid format.
- ▶ The roles of research and technology and the importance of critical thinking, creative problem-solving, and multicultural and global perspectives are emphasized.
- ▶ Two tracks: Professional Certification in Childhood Education (Grades 1-6) or Adolescent Education (Grades 7-12), with Middle School Extension (Grades 5-6).
- ▶ Marist is a member of the Association for Advancing Quality in Educator Preparation.
- ▶ No prior GRE required
- ▶ Students meet course requirements for New York State Professional Teaching Certification.

### **INFORMATION SYSTEMS (CERTIFICATE)**

- ▶ Acquire graduate-level knowledge in an 18-credit program.
- ▶ Open to students with little or no formal IS education.
- ▶ Based in the Computer Science and Mathematics Department for hands-on learning.
- ▶ Courses are from the MS in Information Systems program.

### **INFORMATION SYSTEMS (MS)**

- ▶ Classes are offered both on the main campus in Poughkeepsie and online.
- ▶ Hands-on program based in the Computer Science and Mathematics Department, which is preferred by employers.
- ▶ Graduates of the program have the skills to identify, analyze, and solve business problems, while using a technical systems approach.
- ▶ Three tracks: Information Systems Management, Computer Networks and Security, or Business Analytics.

### **MUSEUM STUDIES (MA)**

- ▶ Offered in Florence, Italy at the Lorenzo de Medici Institute (LdM).
- ▶ May be completed in one year, full-time study, 34-40 credits.
- ▶ Taught by an international faculty in collaboration with the University of Florence and various museums around the city.
- ▶ Fall start only.

### **PHYSICAL THERAPY (DPT)**

- ▶ Offered at the Marist Campus in Poughkeepsie.
- ▶ 36-month, full-time program (115 credits).
- ▶ June start only.
- ▶ Prepares graduates to merge hands-on skills, ethical care, clinical judgment, and critical inquiry to promote optimal functioning of current and future clients throughout their lifespan.

### **PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT STUDIES (MS)**

- ▶ Offered on the main campus in Poughkeepsie.
- ▶ 24-month, full-time program (90 credits).
- ▶ Designed to graduate highly trained, ethical, and problem-solving health care providers.
- ▶ June start only.
- ▶ The Accreditation Review Commission on Education for the Physician Assistant, Inc. (ARC-PA) has granted Accreditation-Continued status to the Marist College Physician Assistant Program sponsored by Marist College. Accreditation-Continued is an accreditation status granted when a currently accredited program is in compliance with the ARC-PA Standards.

### **PROFESSIONAL ACCOUNTANCY (MS)**

- ▶ Designed to provide accounting majors the opportunity to obtain an additional 30 college credits and a graduate degree to satisfy the 150-hour credits to be licensed as a Certified Public Accountant (CPA).
- ▶ Courses are offered on the main campus in Poughkeepsie full-time over the summer and online on a part-time basis in the fall/spring.
- ▶ Can be started in the summer, fall, or spring.

### **PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION (MPA)**

- ▶ 100% online or combined with on-site courses.
- ▶ 5 program start dates a year
- ▶ Offered at the Marist Campus in Poughkeepsie, Albany, or Queens, NY.
- ▶ Courses are offered sequentially in 8-week increments.
- ▶ Concentrations in Analytics, Ethical Leadership, Health Care, Non-Profit Management, and Public Management.

### **SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGY (MA)**

- ▶ Offered on the main campus in Poughkeepsie.
- ▶ Prepares students to meet the educational and psychological needs for K-12 students enrolled in New York State school systems.
- ▶ Graduates of the program are eligible to take the New York State Certification Exam for School Psychologists, and eligible to apply for certification as a Nationally Certified School Psychologist.
- ▶ Approved by the National Association of School Psychologists (NASP).
- ▶ No GRE required
