### HOW IS THE PROFESSIONAL STUDIES MAJOR DIFFERENT FROM THE OTHER MAJORS?

It is no different in academic rigor or quality than other majors. The admission requirements are the same, the faculty are the same, and students earn the same bachelor's degree. The only difference is the format in which the courses are delivered.

#### WHAT IS DIFFERENT ABOUT THE FORMAT?

The courses in the Professional Studies major are a mix of the classes you would find in our "regular" classrooms, online courses, and accelerated versions of courses. This allows students to mix and match according to their schedule and timeline to completion needs.

#### HOW DO LEARN MY DEGREE?

For a bachelor's degree, students must have completed 120 credits in the following areas:

Major (45 credits), Core (42-46 credits), Electives (29-33 credits)

#### **CAN I USE TRANSFER CREDITS?**

Multidisciplinary format of the Professional Studies major allows it to be more transfer credit friendly than most traditional majors at Marist.

#### **CLASSROOM FORMAT**

#### Online (4-week and 8-week)

Online courses are asynchronous in design which provides more flexibility for students. Courses are hosted on a software platform (iLearn) that allows for ease of interaction with professors and classmates.

#### On-ground (15-week)

Courses offered on the Poughkeepsie campus at varying times on the Monday – Friday calendar.

#### Combination

Combine online and on-ground formats in the 4-, 8-, and 15-week calendars as needed for scheduling and access to specific courses.

#### **Blended**

Courses meet in the evening every other week per 8 weeks and include a required online component. Designed to allow students to complete 12 credits per semester to maintain full-time financial aid status.

#### Core:

A bachelor's degree begins with a firm foundation in the liberal arts and sciences. The core introduces students to essential ideas and skills that give students the capacity to synthesize and integrate methods and insights from a variety of intellectual disciplines. Transfer credit friendly.

#### **Electives:**

Whereas the core fulfills specific requirements, electives are different. Students have more flexibility in what to take. Electives are meant to enhance your academic and/or career goals, or allow you to explore an area of interest. Students can go in the other direction of what their major is or take classes that meld with their major. Student may wish to complete a digital badge, minor, or certificate. Electives can be an immense benefit to a professional career.
